- Profile No. 1      Healthy patients 7 and under (CBC and Chem 6):  
 • CBC (Complete Blood Count - Assess anemia, infection and clotting)  
 • BUN (kidney)                      • Glucose (diabetes)                      • ALT (liver)  
 • TP (hydration)                      • Creatinine (kidney)                      • ALKP (liver)
- Profile No. 2      Healthy patients 7 and over (CBC and Chem 12):  
 • Includes all tests in Profile No. 1, plus:  
 • Calcium (certain cancers)      • ALB (protein)                      • Potassium (kidney)  
 • AMYL (pancreas)                      • Bilirubin (liver)                      • Cholesterol (hypothyroid)
- Coagulation Panel      Tests bodies ability to clot.
- Feline Leuk/FIV      Recommended for any cat or kitten never tested.
- Decline      I have elected to refuse the recommended pre-anesthetic screening at this time and request that you proceed with anesthetic/surgery or other procedures necessary. I assume full financial responsibility for said animal(s). I understand the potential risk for complications during anesthesia/surgery/misc procedure(s) without pre-anesthetic screening.

- Laser Surgery      We are pleased to offer you laser surgery for your pet. Why laser surgery? Less pain, less bleeding and less swelling. This means a reduced risk of infection, reduced trauma to your pet and rapid recovery.
- Decline      I have elected to refuse laser surgery.

- Therapy Laser      Post surgically this deep penetrating light allows relief of pain through the release of endorphins and stimulates the injured cells to heal faster.
- Decline      I have elected to refuse therapy laser.

- E-Collar      A collar should be worn for 14 days after a procedure to prevent your pet from chewing and licking at the incision site.
- Decline      I already own an E-Collar and will bring it to be utilized on my pet upon being discharged.

- Microchip implant      A microchip is implanted between your pet's shoulder blades, under the skin, for identification.
- Decline      I have elected to decline a microchip implant.
